Dear Bryant Ranch Parents/Guardians:

Below is the school supply list, which is completely voluntary. Please be assured that all classroom supplies will be provided to every student, but we greatly appreciate your donations of any of these items! **(These items may be shared, so we prefer you don't label them with names.)** Remember, students **may not** bring the following items to school:

Liquid paper Toys (anything that is not required that distracts from work) Desk decorations

Your child's teacher may ask for additional supplies at a later date for specific classroom activities. Thank you for your continued support of Bryant Ranch.

In case of an emergency, each student must also have a gallon size Ziploc baggie labeled with their name and teacher name containing non-perishable food items (check expiration dates to ensure the items will last the full school year).

Some suggested items are:

- 2 - 17 oz bottles of water (no juice, please)
- 2 cheese and cracker or peanut butter and cracker snack packs
- 2 dried fruit snacks, such as fruit rolls, fun fruits, or raisins
- 1 pop-top container of fruit or pudding and a plastic spoon

other ideas: beef jerky, trail mix, peanuts, pop-top container of tuna, chicken, etc.

Another option will be to order pre-made emergency packs that will be available for purchase the first week of school.

(Labeled with student name)
1 box 24 (maximum) Crayola crayons
1 large container hand wipes or sanitizing gel
1 box 8-10 colored pencils
1 package brown paper lunch bags

Last name A-L - 1 box broad, primary color washable markers

Last name M-Z - 1 box thin, color washable markers

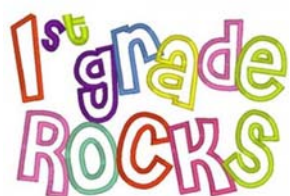


Each child should have a backpack (no rollers, please) and bring a nutritious snack every day in a labeled soft vinyl lunch bag.

First Grade

12 glue sticks
4 dozen sharpened No. 2 pencils
2 boxes Crayola crayons (24 count max)
2 Pink Pearl erasers
2 packages of 12 Crayola colored pencils
1 set, 8 classic colors washable Crayola markers
Two 70-sheet wide-ruled spiral homework notebooks
A plastic pencil box **no larger than 5 1/2" x 8"**
1 pair of metal 'Fiskar's for Kids' scissors with points
(please label scissors with student's name)

2 containers hand wipes
2 large boxes facial tissues
1 ream 8½ x 11 white cardstock
1 ream 8 1/2x11, 20 lb. white copy paper
2 containers antibacterial "sanitizing" wipes
1 box latex-free band aids

Second Grade

- 1 **1-inch** 3 ring basic **view** binder
- 1 pair of 'Fiskar's for Kids' scissors with points
- 1 box of crayons (**no larger than 24**) made in U.S.A.
- Pencil box (cardboard or plastic) **no larger than 5 1/2" x 8"**
- 2 large containers hand wipes
- 1 ream white 65 lb cardstock or colored copy paper
- 2 large boxes facial tissues

- 2 small glue sticks
- 3 dozen **sharpened** No. 2 pencils
- 1 package of large Expo markers
- 2 large containers antibacterial "sanitizing" wipes
- 1 large hand sanitizer pump bottle
- 1 ream 8½ x 11, 20 lb. white copy paper

In addition, each child needs an Emergency Bag (see **bold** paragraph above). Also, we would suggest you have a children's dictionary, a thesaurus, colored pencils, and a ruler at home for your child.

Third Grade

- 1 pair of scissors (kid's scissors **with** points)



- 1 package **wide-ruled** 3 hole punched notebook paper
- 1 **small** box to hold supplies **no larger than 5½" x 8"**
- 1 box of 16 crayons
- 1 container antibacterial "cleaning" wipes
- 2 composition books, 9¾" x 7½", 100 sheets each
- 1 ream 8½ x 11, 20 lb. white copy paper
- Emergency Bag (see **bold** paragraph on front)

Fourth Grade

- 1 8" x 5 x 2" plastic pencil box
